BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
APRIL 10, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Billy Ray Jackson.

Mayor Jackson led the Board of Commissioners in the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America.

Commissioner Spikes made a motion to accept March minutes as presented. Seconded by Commissioner Smith. Motion carried unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA

Garris to operate an automobile repair shop in the RA-20 District. Action to set date for Tuesday, May 1st, 6:15 p.m.
- #2 Action to approve Budget Adjustments and Amendments.

CONSIDERATION/ACTION ITEMS

Commissioner Smith made a motion to approve the addendum to Elections Agreement between the Town of Grifton and Pitt County Board of Elections. Seconded by Commissioner Clements. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Spikes made a motion to table the issue of the Town possibly purchasing parcel # 11027 from Jimmy Maynard. Seconded by Commissioner Hill. After further discussion the motion was carried unanimously.

Commissioner Hill made a motion to appoint Eber Mitchell to the Grifton Community Development Committee. Seconded by Commissioner Spikes. Motion carried unanimously.
