BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
February 12, 2013**

Mayor Jackson called the meeting to order.

Mayor Jackson led the Board of Commissioners in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Commissioner Hill made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 2013-02. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. The motion was carried unanimously.
3. *Proclamation for the 102nd Birthday of Nancy Davis Morgan*
Commissioner Barnes made a motion to proclaim February 28th, 2013 as Nancy Davis Morgan Day. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Albritton. The motion was carried unanimously.

Commissioner Comments

Commissioner Bright mentioned that it looks like there is mortar coming out of the bricks on the Pitt Street side of the Harvey Building.

Commissioner Whitehurst asked if there was any way the Town could discourage the School buses from cutting across the corners of the roads. He stated that it is doing damage to the pavement and property.

Commissioner Bright gave Manager Albright the names of individuals to contact at Pitt County Schools.

Commissioner Barnes asked who would be doing the patchwork on the streets that are being torn up by the Sewer Rehab Contractors.

Manager Albright stated that the contractor is responsible for paving the areas where the work is being done. However, the contractors are not finished with the areas at this point in the project.

Mayor Jackson stated that some of the holes in the roads need more attention.

Mayor Jackson thanked the audience for attending the meeting.

Commissioner Whitehurst made a motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bright. The motion was carried unanimously.
