The regular town board meeting was called to order by Mayor Moore

Minutes for June 9, and called meeting, June 27: Motion to approve minutes:
Commissioner Godwin, 2nd Commissioner Franks. Motion carried unanimously.

Approve Bills for Payment: Motion to approve bills for July, 09: Commissioner Lucas, 2nd
Commissioner Godwin. Motion carried unanimously.

Budget Amendment: Motion to approve final budget amendments 4, 5, 6: 1st Commissioner
Lucas, 2nd Commissioner Smith. Motion carried unanimously.

Reappoint Barbara Aycock Town Administrator, Town Clerk, Finance Officer, Zoning
Administrator and Candy Minshew for Deputy Clerk for 2009-10. Motion to approve: 1st
Commissioner Roland Lucas, 2nd Commissioner Smith, Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioners:

Lucas: Pass. Park! We need to meet on the park. We said that last month and we have
not done that yet. Aycock: Do you want me to finish up with the park? We have the water
fountain, walking trail, and sidewalks. Commissioner Lucas: Yes, that is the final stages.
Aycock: I just want to make sure I am going in the right direction the park committee wants me
to go in and finalize. Commissioner Dawson: Motion to go ahead and finish park grant, 2nd
Commissioner Lucas. Motion carried unanimously.

Franks: Pass

Godwin: Pass. Electricity is going up and flowing good.

Smith: I don't have anything at this time.

Dawson: The only thing I have to say is I will be working on the sidewalks and will
present it to the board. Moore: You will bring this up at a later meeting? Dawson: Yes
sir.

Next thing is Department Heads. Greg Gates is not here. Ms. Aycock do you have anything?

Aycock: The only thing I have is to get the finalization for the water treatment plant. We have
been authorized to go to bid and Ron Sutton is working on bid information and it should be the
Wilson Daily Times next week. We do not have to go through the LGC so the bid date could
change again. This frees up some time for the grant and bids since we do not have to wait for

LGC approval. It is a big detail thing to go through. The application is about an inch thick.
Moore: This should help us met the October deadline. Aycock: I also talked with Liz Hurley with the NC Rural Center because I was getting nervous about the October deadline and she told me if I needed an extension I could get one. I wanted to get that base covered so if something happen we did not make it I had some insurance that there was an extension.

Commissioner Smith: I figured it would go right to the wire.

Aycock: She said you did not have to have the shovel in the dirt, I was talking with her about this and getting more specific with her, she said as long as contract was signed. Contract ready is what she stated. Moore: As long as you have the contract signed that's what counts. Aycock: I just wanted to make sure all these loose ends were closed up, and Mayor Moore can attest that we have worked very diligently on this to get all the approvals.

Audience: Pass

Commissioner Godwin: The reason Greg Gates is not here he asked to be excused they have been pretty tight these last five weeks. Next thing what is the status on Robert Murray?

Commissioner Franks: I think he is supposed to go back to the doctor. It is suppose to be in July.

Aycock: I have not received another doctor note, and I spoke to Joe Fortson about it. Godwin: Was it the 16th he was suppose to go back? Aycock: I think so.

Commissioner Lucas: Have we heard anything else from Greg on the advertising for the water job? Moore: I think they are working up a notice now. Aycock: We have been concentrating on these grants lately.

Mayor Moore: Read announcements. I congratulate Ms. Aycock on her scholarship with the School of Government.

Any more for the meeting. Meeting adjourned.
