7:30 REGULAR MEETING MARCH 14, 2006

Meeting called to order by Mayor Billy Ray Jackson.

Mayor Jackson led the Board of Commissioners in the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States of America.

Minutes approved as written on a motion by Commissioner Spikes. Seconded by Commissioner Craft. Motion carried.

Administrator Condon presented the revised Open Burning Ordinance. However, after further discussion, the Board decided to table the issue until the next workshop meeting to discuss the penalty issue.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hill to approve the proclamation declaring Friday, April 28th as Arbor Day in the Town of Grifton. Seconded by Commissioner Craft. Motion carried.
