SUBJECT: Manager's Comments for the May Regular Meeting

Below I have attempted to summarize and provide explanation for each agenda item.

### Item E-1: Neuse Regional Water and Sewer Authority – Board Appointment

My term on the NRWASA Board of Directors will expire in June. Therefore, the Board of Commissioners needs to appoint someone to fill that vacancy for the upcoming three (3) year term. I am willing and able to serve. Therefore, I recommend approval of Resolution: 2010-04 via the Consent Agenda.

#### **Item E-2:** Rezoning Request – Schedule Public Hearing

We have received a request to rezone Parcel #18598, located in front of the Highway 11 Mobile Home Park. In order for the process to move forward, a public hearing on the matter needs to be scheduled. I recommend the public hearing be held during our regular meeting on June 8<sup>th</sup>. The Planning Board will hear the request on May 20<sup>th</sup> and make a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners.
