Commissioner Hill made a motion to set the date for a Public Hearing regarding the FY 09-10 Town Budget for Tuesday, June 9th at 6:45 p.m. Seconded by Commissioner Spikes. Motion carried unanimously.

Manager Condon informed the Board that Angel Hudson had won the Outstanding Administrative Personnel Award given by the NCRWA and will receive it at an awards banquet held in Greensboro, NC on Wednesday.

COMMISSIONER COMMENTS

Commissioner Spikes asked if we had heard anything from D.O.T. concerning the speed limit change on N. Highland Blvd. Commissioner Spikes also commented that the Town of Grifton

website needs to be updated with the new meeting times.

Commissioner Clements informed the Board that in his observance he has seen 2 or 3 streets in Grifton with grass on them. He also stated that he thought a speed limit sign needed to be put in front of the Christian Church.
