OCTOBER 10, 2006

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Billy Ray Jackson.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Craft made a motion to deny the request from Rev. David Moore for the Town of Grifton to absorb the cost of vacant lot cutting at Field of Dreams Subdivision. Seconded by Commissioner Spikes. Motion carried unanimously.

Consideration of setting a date for a public hearing for a conditional use permit application for Debra Hardy was postponed by the Board until the Planning Board makes their recommendation.

Manager Condon informed the Board that the trees at the corner of Church and McCrae Street will be pruned back this week.

Manager Condon also informed the Board that the inmates are working in Town and to let him know if there was a specific place that needed attention.
