Meeting called to order.

\*\$400.00 per month car allowance.

\*Mr. Albright will have to have Board approval prior to hiring or firing employees for the 6 month interim period.

Motion seconded by Commissioner Hill. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Craft motioned to adjourn. Seconded by Commissioner Spikes. Motion carried unanimously.
